Spring 2017 Budget Adjustments


Allocations Summary:

- 02/01/2017 04/31/2017
- 95 allocations
- \$65,604 allocated

Budget Adjustments:

- Add \$75 for travel to CASPAR fundraiser.
- Add \$250 to Arts and Music Exhibition CH.

Bylaw Amendment Introduction

• Combine Floor 1 and Floor 2S

- easier to hold events/get enough people and budget.
- Add vote for Interhall Committee
 - Officially recognize the Interhall Coordinator position, made up of Interest Groups and Daily Life Officer.
- Reweight Hall Councilor votes to (Total non HC votes) / (# of hall councilors) ~ 2.5 in full gov't.
 - Balance votes between elected reps and others.
- Remove Kappa Alpha Theta sorority reference.
- Add explicit reference to SPICE in cultural committee.
 - Deserves an explicit reference to how its vote counts.
- If passed, amendment will take effect at the start of the April house meeting.

Bylaw Amendment Introduction

If passed, this bylaw amendment will take effect when the full 17-18 house government takes office.

In Section 1b of the bylaws, Office of Halls:

Deletion of halls "Floor 2-South and Floor 1-South."

Addition of "Floors 1 and 2-South."

Deletion of paragraph referring to members of Kappa Alpha Theta sorority.

Addition of "In addition to managing the hall council, the Chair of the Halls shall have oversight of the following Standing Committee:

i. Interhall Committee - Charged with the development and oversight of resident-driven communities and events, as well as initiatives to improve the daily lives of residents.

In Section 1d of the bylaws, Office of Residential Life:


Revision of description of Cultural Committee to add: ", including but not limited to the SPICE program."

In Section 2 of the bylaws:

Replacement of "Member of the Executive Council and the Cabinet shall receive one vote while each Hall Councilor shall receive two" by "Each member of the Executive Council and each non-empty Committee in the Cabinet shall receive one vote. Each Hall Councilor shall receive a (possibly fractional) number of votes equal to the total number of non-empty committees and non-empty Executive Council positions divided by the number of hall councilors."
