



This term, we had an opportunity to meet two famous MIT professors right here at SP, and two more to come on April 6 and May 5. Peter Diamond, 2010 Nobel Laureate in Economic Sciences, talked about "Search Frictions, Unemployment, and Vacancies" - one of the most quivering topics of the present


